Lodging info: See readerange.org Lodging link in the task bar. Camping is permitted on the range at no additional cost. Campers may be parked at the 1000 yard parking lot. Tent camping or small campers can set up in the camping areas on the west side of the range at the 500 & 600 yard lines. NO ONE is permitted in these camping areas during live fire. There is no water or power service on the range. Portable sanitation units are placed along the range.

Rules: All NRA International Fullbore rifle rules will apply.

1. Rifles. Rule 3.3.5(a) & (b) Target Rifle With metallic Sights Chambered in unmodified .308 or 223. No Trigger weight restriction, triggers must be safe.

2. Ammunition: Rule 3.17(a) .308/7.62mm with a maximum bullet weight of 156 grain or .223/5.56mm with a maximum bullet weight of 92 grain.

F-Class - Rule 3.17(b) No bullet weight restrictions, ammunition must be safe, and 35 caliber or under. Rifles blowing primers will be removed from the firing line.

Empty Chamber Indicator: ECI use will be required at all times except during prep periods, live fire, or the direct discretion of the line officer.

Targets & Scoring: Electronic targets will be used on all firing lanes. Competitors will be required to perform scoring duty related to their target daily. A limited number of scoring tablets will be made available, however it is recommended competitors bring their own scoring tablet.

Smoking/ Alcohol: Smoking is not permitted on the firing line. Competitors may smoke at any time behind the ready line. Cigarette Butts are considered trash and must be disposed of properly. Alcoholic beverages will be permitted at the end of each day once all firing has been completed and the range has been called cold.

Entry: This tournament is open to all individuals with safe rifle and ammunition. All participants are required to pre-register including their match fees by May 25, 2023. See attached entry form. Refunds will be made if you notification is made by the evening of May 25. Team fees will be collected the day of the team match at the stat office.

Squadding: squadding announcements will be made daily between 7:00 and 7:30 am. Range Capacity - 100

Safety: There will be a safety brief daily before commencing fire. Competitors are required to have zeros before the match commences. In the event you do not have a hard zero for your rifle let the line officer know and you will be helped to establish a hard zero. Hunting for a zero on the electronic targets will not be permitted. All competitors are considered safety officers, In the event you see an unsafe condition do not hesitate in calling a cease fire. Firing time will be stopped until safe conditions are reestablished and firing can commence.

Relays & Scoring: The tournament will include both pair firing and string firing. When pair firing, Relays 1 & 2 will alternate shots and score each other. Relays 3 & 4 will alternate shots and score each other. When pair firing each shooter will have 45 seconds to complete their next shot after scoring your mound competitor's shot. Abuse of the 45 second rule needs to be reported to the line officer, one warning will be given to the shooter to stay within their time bracket. Warnings after the first warning will constitute forfeiting your shot. While string firing shooters will always move from your firing relay to scoring the next firing relay.

Practice: May 25 & 26 will be squadded practice days before the tournament. There will be no charge for these days.

Match 1 Team Match: Saturday May 27. 300, 600, 900, & 1000 yards. 4 man team firing 2 sighters and 10 record shots per team member per stage.

Stage #1 Block Time 54 minutes. 300 yards slow fire prone on MR63 or MR63FC target. Coaches may bring two to the mound.

Stage #2 Block time 54 minutes. 600 yards slow fire prone on MR-1 or MR-1FC target. Coaches may bring two to the mound.

Stage #3 Block time 66 minutes. 900 yards slow fire prone on LR or LRFC target. Coaches may bring two to the mound.

Stage #4 Block time 66 minutes. 1000 yards slow fire prone on LR or LRFC target. Coaches may bring tow to the mound.

Championship Team will be determined by high aggregate Team score of stages 1-4. 1600 points possible.

Match #2 Sunday May 28. Pair Firing @ 300, 500, 600 yards, String firing at 900 yards. 45 second rule will apply. 22 Minuets per shooter per all stages.

Stage #1: 2 convertible sighters and 10 record shots at 300 yards on MR63 or MR63FC target

Stage #2: 2 convertible sighters and 10 record shots at 500 yards on MR65 or MR65FC target.

Stage #3: 2 convertible sighters and 10 record shots at 600 yards on MR-1 or MR-1FC target.

Stage #4: 2 convertible sighters and 15 record shots at 900 yards on LR or LRFC target.

Match #2 Daily aggregate of stages 1-4. 450 points possible.

Match #3 Monday May 29. Pair Firing @ 300.500, 600 yards. String firing at 1000 yards. 45 second rule will apply. 22 minutes per shooter per all stages.

Stage #1: 2 convertible sighters and 10 record shots at 300 yards on MR63 or MR63FC target.

Stage #2: 2 @ convertible sighters and 10 record shots at 500 yards on MR65 or MR65FC target.

Stage #3: 2 convertible sighters and 10 record shots at 600 yards on MR1 or MR1FC target.

Stage #4: 2 convertible sighters and 15 record shots at 1000 yards on LR or LRFC target.

Match #3 Daily aggregate of stages 1-4. 450 points possible.

Match #4: Tuesday May 30 Pair firing @ 300,500,600 yards. String Firing at 1000 yards. 45 second rule will apply. 22 minutes per shooter per all stages.

Stage # 1: 2 convertible sighters and 10 record shots at 300 yards on MR63 or MR63FC target.

Stage #2: 2 convertible sighters and 10 record shots at 500 yards on MR65 or MR65FC target.

Stage #3: 2 convertible sighters and 10 record shots at 600 yards on MR1 or MR1FC target.

Stage #4: 2 convertible sighters and 15 record shots at 1000 yards on LR or LRFC target.

Match#4 Daily aggregate of Stages 1-4 450 points possible.

Match #5: Regional course Aggregate (Matches 2,3,4) Individual Champion.

Match#6: Wednesday May 31. String fire. All stages, 22 minutes per stage.

Stage #1: Unlimited sighters and 15 record shots at 800 yards on LR or LRFC target.

Stage #2: 2 convertible sighters and 15 record shots at 900 yards on LR or LRFC target.

Stage #3: 2 convertible sighters and 15 record shots at 1000 yards on LR or LRFC target.

Match #6 Daily aggregate of stages 1-3 450 Points Possible.

Match # 7: Thursday June 1. String fire. All stages, 22 minutes per stage.

Stage #1: Unlimited sighters and 15 record shots at 800 yards on LR or LRFC target.

Stage #2: 2 convertible sighters and 15 record shot at 900 Yards on LR or LRFC target.

Stage #3: 2 convertible sighters and 15 record shots at 1000 yards on LR or LRFC target.

Match #7: Daily aggregate stages 1-3. 450 points possible.

Match #8: Long Range Aggregate (Matches 6,&7) Individual Champion.

Match #9: Grand Aggregate (Matches 5 -8) Individual Champion.
