

Reade Long Range 200 Round Championship Program

\$1000.00 in prize cash

Members of the Western Pa Cal. 30 League have opportunity to compete for a season cash prize of at least \$1000.00 by having the highest percentage average with a minimum of 200 rounds fired out of 405 rounds in the season.

Rules: 1. MUST be a Western Pa Cal. 30 League member. Memberships will be accepted after the start of the season. There will be a \$5.00 fee to be placed on the roll of the program.

2. ALL rounds fired during listed matches MUST be turned in and counted toward average.

3. Awards will be broken down as follows, Conventional Prone any sight, F-Class Open, F-TR, and Palma. You will need to have fired a minimum of 200 rounds in your respective class to be eligible for awards. There must be at least two shooters in each respective class to be eligible.

4. Shooters may choose any combination of the listed matches to make up their 200 round qualification.

- 3. May 15 60 rounds**
- 4. June 5 60 rounds (Regional)**
- 5. June 6 40 rounds (Regional)**
- 6. July 17 65 rounds (palma plus 20)**
- 7. Sept. 3 60 rounds (LR State championship)**
