

Western Pa. .30 Cal. League John C. Garand/Springfield Bolt Match

Date: June 28, 2008

Location: Reade Range, Alleman's Pa. For directions please go to the web site at www.readerang.org

Time: The first relay will begin at 9:00am. Registration will begin at 7:45am.

Competition open to: Open invitation.

Rules: Current CMP rules will apply.

Fee: \$20.00

Equipment: Any "as issued" .30 cal American service rifle such as the M1 Garand, 1903 Springfield, 1917 Enfield, 1941 Johnson, M1 Carbine and U.S. Krag.

Course of fire: Course A will be used which is 35 shots. 5 sighters and 30 for record. This will consist of 2 matches which will be a John Garand match and a Springfield bolt match to be fired for a total of 70 rounds. The Garand match will be fired first followed by the Springfield match. All stages will be fired on the 200yd SR target.

Stage 1 – Prone, slow fire, 5 sighters and 10 record shots 15 minutes.

Stage 2 – Prone from standing rapid fire, 10 shots, 70 seconds. (80 seconds for the Springfield match)

Stage 3 – Standing, slow fire, 10 shots, 10 minutes.

Ammunition: Competitors may use their own. There will be M2 ball available for those that may need ammo for a small fee.

AWARDS: Competitors will be issued a **CMP** certificate for eligibility to purchase surplus rifles, ammo and accessories at the match.
