Across the Course Matches

Dates: 4/15/12, 4/29/12, 5/20/12, 6/17/12, 7/22/12, 10/14/12

80 round course of fire:

2 sighting shots and 20 for record standing, slow fire, SR target, 200 yds

2 sighting shots and 20 for record sitting or kneeling from standing, rapid fire, CMP rules, SR target 200 yds.

2 sighting shots and 20 for record prone from standing, rapid fire, CMP rules, SR-3 target, 300 yds.

2 sighting shots and 20 for record prone slow fire, MR-1 target 600 yds.

Benchrest Matches

Long Range Matches

All Long Range League matches will be 3 x 1000

Match # 1 Any Rifle / Any Sight and F-open & F-TR

Match # 2 Any Rifle / Iron Sight and F-open & F-TR

Match # 3 Palma Rifle and F- open & F-TR

League will Pay \$20.00 per match to the winners provided there are 5 shooters in each Rifle class.

League will Pay \$10.00 per match to the first loser provided there are 10 shooters in each rifle class.

Competitors have freedom to fire outside of match program, however must fire within the individual match program to be eligible for cash award.

A Competitors who is able to win all three matches in a single day will receive an extra \$30.00, making the total take for the day \$90.00

Black Powder Matches

Dates: 5/12/12, 9/15/12

Times: Registration 7:30-9:00 AM
Mandatory shooter's meeting 8:45 AM
Match starts at 9:00 AM

Fees: Tournament Fee \$5.50
Entry Fee \$20.00

Rules: All current NRA black powder target rifle rules apply. If a competitor only has an NRA BPCR silhouette classification they will be assigned these classifications accordingly: Master-Master, AAA-Expert, AA-Sharpshooter, A or B-Marksman.

Eligibility: Open to all up to range capacity of 100 shooters, 4 relays, initially 1 shooting, 2 scoring, 3 and 4 pit duty.

Course of fire: 30 shot long range course. 10 sighting shots and 10 shots for record in 30 minutes, any position, at 800, 900, and 1000 yds. Target used is LR target.

Equipment: Any black powder cartridge rifle shall not weigh more than 15 lbs. Period metallic sight, period scope with Malcom style mounts. No click adjustments in the mount. Shooter may use ground cloth and spotting scope. A cotton shooting jacket may be used.

Ammunition: Lead alloy bullets, no gas checks. Black powder or Pyrodex may be used. No duplex loads, no smokeless powder. Ammunition must meet power factor:

40 Cal. - 400 Gr. bullets @ 1280 FPS

44 Cal. - 430 Gr. bullets @ 1240 FPS

45 Cal. - 450 Gr. bullets @ 1220 FPS or 500 Gr. bullets @ 1200 FPS

Awards: 40% cash Payback

Facilities: Job Johnny restrooms (2), no food or water. Primitive camping is available at the range.

Safety: All persons on the firing line are urged to wear eye and ear protection. Open block indicators are mandatory. No alcoholic beverages permitted.

Practice: May 13th and September 9th. Start at 10:00 AM Range fee: \$5.00.

M1 Garand & Springfield Bolt Match

Dates: 5/26/12, 9/1/12

Current CMP rules will apply.

Equipment: Any "as issued" .30 cal American service rifle such as the M1 Garand, 1903 Springfield, 1917 Enfield, 1941 Johnson, M1 Carbine and U.S. Krag.

Course of fire: Course "A" will be used which is 35 shots. 5 sighters and 30 for record. This will consist of 2 matches which will be a John Garand match and a Springfield bolt match to be fired for a total of 70 rounds. The Garand match will be fired first followed by the Springfield match.

Each relay will fire both matches consecutively. All stages will be fired on the 200yd SR target.

Stage 1 – Prone, slow fire, 5 sighters and 10 record shots 15 minutes.

Stage 2 – Prone from standing rapid fire, 10 shots, 70 seconds. (80 seconds for the Springfield match)

Stage 3 – Standing, slow fire, 10 shots, 10 minutes.

Ammunition: Competitors will use their own ammo.

AWARDS: Competitors will be issued a **CMP** certificate for eligibility to purchase surplus rifles, ammo and accessories at the match.
