**Across the Course Matches**

Dates: 3/17/13, 4/21/13, 5/19/13, 10/27/13, 11/2/13

80 round course of fire:

- 2 sighting shots and 20 for record standing, slow fire, SR target, 200 yds
- 2 sighting shots and 20 for record sitting or kneeling from standing, rapid fire, CMP rules, SR target 200 yds.
- 2 sighting shots and 20 for record prone from standing, rapid fire, CMP rules, SR-3 target, 300 yds.
- 2 sighting shots and 20 for record prone slow fire, MR-1 target 600 yds.

League Meeting 9/22/13

50 round course of fire:

- 2 sighting shots and 10 for record standing, slow fire, SR target, 200 yds
- 2 sighting shots and 10 for record sitting or kneeling from standing, rapid fire, CMP rules, SR target 200 yds.
- 2 sighting shots and 10 for record prone from standing, rapid fire, CMP rules, SR-3 target, 300 yds.
- 2 sighting shots and 20 for record prone slow fire, MR-1 target 600 yds.

### **Long Range Matches**

Dates: 3/16/13, 4/20/13, 5/18/13, 7/6/13, 7/28/13, 9/21/13, 11/1/13

Course of fire: Palma course plus 20 at 1000 yards

Unlimited sighters and 15 record shots from 800 yards on LR or LRFC target in 22 minutes.

Two sighters and 15 record shots from 900 yards on LR or LRFC target in 22 minutes.

Two sighters and 15 record shots from 1000 yards on LR or LRFC target in 22 minutes.

Unlimited sighters and 20 record shots from 1000 yards on LR or LRFC target in 30 minutes.

Match open to any target rifle under 35 caliber in long range sling, F- Class Open, & F-TR.  
All matches will be in a three relay rotation. Shooters are obligated to pit and scoring duties.  
Match fee \$20.00

Awards will be paid out if there are FIVE or more in a rifle class as listed.

1. High Palma rifle across Palma course.
2. High F- Open rifle across Palma course.
3. High F-TR rifle across Palma course.
4. High Target rifle at 1000 yards.
5. High F- Open rifle at 1000 yards.
6. High F-TR rifle at 1000 yards.

### **Mid Range Matches**

Dates: 3/23/13, 4/28/13, 5/26/13, 6/29/13, 7/20/13, 9/28/13, 10/26/13

Course of fire: Mid Range Palma course

Unlimited sighters and 15 record shots at 300 yards in 17 minutes on MR-63 or 63FC target.

Two sighters and 15 record shots at 500 yards in 17 minutes on MR-65 or 65FC target.

Two sighters and 15 record shots at 600 yards in 17 minutes on MR-1 or MR-1FC target.

Match will be fired on a three relay rotation. Shooters are obligated to pit and scoring duties.

Match fee \$20.00

Awards will be given based on FIVE shooters per rifle category.

1. High Match rifle
2. High Service rifle
3. High F- Class open rifle
4. High F-TR rifle

Rattle Battle Match: This is a fun match and is not registered with CMP or NRA.

Following the mid range match there will be a 600, 500, 300, rattle battle type match. Time limits on this match are yet to be established because of terrain of the range.

Match is open to competitors with rapid fire rifles. F-TR shooters are welcome. Competitors will be required to do pit duty. Match fee \$5.00. Start time approx. 1:00.

## **M1 Garand & Springfield Bolt Match**

Date: 6/15/13

Current CMP rules will apply.

**Equipment:** Any "as issued" .30 cal American service rifle such as the M1 Garand, 1903 Springfield, 1917 Enfield, 1941 Johnson, M1 Carbine and U.S. Krag.

**Course of fire:** Course "A" will be used which is 35 shots. 5 sighters and 30 for record. This will consist of 2 matches which will be a John Garand match and a Springfield bolt match to be fired for a total of 70 rounds. The Garand match will be fired first followed by the Springfield match.

Each relay will fire both matches consecutively. All stages will be fired on the 200yd SR target.

Stage 1 – Prone, slow fire, 5 sighters and 10 record shots 15 minutes.

Stage 2 – Prone from standing rapid fire, 10 shots, 70 seconds. (80 seconds for the Springfield match)

Stage 3 – Standing, slow fire, 10 shots, 10 minutes.

**Ammunition:** Competitors will use their own ammo.

**AWARDS:** Competitors will be issued a **CMP** certificate for eligibility to purchase surplus rifles, ammo and accessories at the match.
