Date: May 31, 2013 – 1,000 yd Individual Practice (10:00am -12:00pm) – 4-Man Team Match (Entries Close 12:30) (Start 1:00pm)
June 1, 2013 – 3 x 1,000 (entries close 7:30 am)(Start 8:00 am)
June 2, 2013 – 3 x 1,000 (entries close 7:30 am)(Start 8:00 am)

Location: Reade Range is located at 1257 Wippers Road, Fallen Timber PA. From I-80 - Exit I-80 South at Milesburg, continue on US220/I-99 to Tyrone. At Tyrone take Rt.453 West to Rt. 253. Turn South onto Rt. 253 to town of Allemans. At crossroads in center of town turn West (Right) toward Beccarria, travel 1000 yds. Turn Left on to dirt road at cemetery (Large white Church on Right). Stay on dirt road, 1.1 miles, range road is on Right at sign and gate. For directions from Rt. 22 please visit www.readerange.org

Rules: Current NRA High Power Rifle Long Range Prone and F Class Long Range Prone Classification rules will apply. Empty chamber indicators (Rule 3.21) **MUST** be used by all competitors.

Safety: For the safety of the pit crew, a competitor who fails to get on target in **TEN SHOTS** may be directed to stop firing. For the purposes of this rule, an oblong hole from a ricochet does NOT count as a hit. All sighting shots must be scored on back of score card. Bolts cannot be closed until the rifle is shouldered and pointed towards the target.

Eligibility: NRA membership is no longer required to compete in NRA tournaments. Competitors must be an NRA member to set an NRA National Record.

Service Rifle – Rule 3.1
Any Rifle Iron Sight – Rule 3.2

“F” Class: See Section 22 Rule 3.4 in NRA High Power Rifle Rules

4-Man Team Match: Palma® Rifle – Rule 3.3.1, Sight – Metallic Only – Rule 3.7(a)
Any Rifle – Rule 3.2, Any Sight – Rule 3.7(c)

Entries: Individual entries will be made by using the enclosed entry form accompanied by a check or money order. Be sure to indicate your correct NRA Long Range Prone or F Class Prone classification. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6- Assigned Classification, or 19.2 – Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry. **IF YOU ARE NOT CHECKED IN AT THE STAT OFFICE 30 MINUTES BEFORE FIRING TIME, YOUR SPOT WILL BE GIVEN TO A PERSON ON THE WAITING LIST.** Mail individual entry form with correct fees to:

Across the board entries will take precedence over one day entries, and will be accepted up to range capacity (100) until May 24. Practice and Team Matches are payable the day of the event. Confirmations will be sent by email or US mail. Any entries received after May 24 will be considered late and charged a late entry fees. **If you cannot attend the match, please notify me immediately. Thank you.**

Targets: The NRA International Fullbore Prone scoring system will be used -Rule 14.18(b). Sample cards will be given at registration. Long Range targets will be used at 1,000 yd
“F” Class Targets will be used at 1,000 yd –LR-FC
Pit shuttle will be provided by range officials.
Pit pullers are planned to be available at a cost of \$25.00 per day per shooter for June 1st and June 2nd.

Squadding: Individual matches will be squadded before the event. Individual packets will be available for pick up at the Stat Office on Friday May, 31 and during registration. A competitor who fails to present himself/herself at the proper firing point when his/her relay is called may lose his/her right to compete in that event. Squadding for the Team Match will be given at the Firing Line when registration is complete. Special squadding requests **MUST** be made on the registration application.

Course of Fire: (competitors will score)

Friday, May 31 – 11:00 am (Team Captains must register by 12:30 pm)

Practice will start at the 1,000 yd line at 10:00 AM

Team Match: 4-Man Team -2 sighters & 20 shots each firing member at 1,000 yd
two 60 minute time periods/match

Saturday, June 1 – 8:00 am

Match 1: 1,000 yd Individual, 20 shots, Palma® Rifle, or Service Rifle, or Any/Iron, or F-Class, Unlimited sighters, 30 minutes

Match 2: 1,000 yd Individual, 20 shots, Palma® Rifle, or Service Rifle, or Any/Iron, or F-Class, Unlimited sighters, 30 minutes

Match 3: 1,000 yd Individual, 20 shots, Palma® Rifle, or Service Rifle, or Any/Iron, or F-Class, Unlimited sighters, 30 minutes

Match 4: Day 1 Aggregate (Matches 1,2,3)

Sunday, June 2 – 8:00 am

Match 5: 1,000 yd Individual, 20 shots, Palma® Rifle, or Service Rifle, or Any/Any, or F-Class, Unlimited sighters, 30 minutes

Match 6: 1,000 yd Individual, 20 shots, Palma® Rifle, or Service Rifle, or Any/Any, or F-Class, Unlimited sighters, 30 minutes

Match 7: 1,000 yd Individual, 20 shots, Palma® Rifle, or Service Rifle, or Any/Any, or F-Class, Unlimited sighters, 30 minutes

Match 8: Day 2 Aggregate (Matches 4,5,6)

Match 9: Regional Championship Aggregate (Matches 7,8)

A Special Award will be given to competitors who use a Palma® Rifle or Service Rifle for all Matches when 5 or more compete.

Awards: 50% of the individual entry fees will be returned to the competitors in cash awards. One place will be awarded in each class for every 5 competitors. If there are less than five individuals or three teams in a class, they will be combined with the next class, except for High Masters. Lower classes will not be combined with the High Master class.

“F” Class Competitors: All individual events are open to participation by F-Class competitors. 50% of the individual F-Class entry fees will be returned to the competitors in cash awards. Awards in F-Class will be made based upon the number of competitors in each category (Open and TR) shooting in the match.

4-Man Team Match: Medals will be awarded to the winners of the 4-Man Team Match based on the number of teams entered in each category. Rifles to be used are: Palma® Rifle, Service Rifle, Any/Iron, Any/Any, F-Class Open or TR.

Meals: Tom Ferraro will be providing a meal on the range June 1st & 2nd after the final match and before Prize/Award Ceremonies. Tables are provided, but please remember to bring a chair. Also, Applied Ballistics will be sponsoring a “Hospitality Tent” with snacks and drinks on June 1st & 2nd.

Notes: There is no rain date set for this match. The match will continue to run in light to moderate rain. In the event of a heavy rain the match will be canceled and match fees will be refunded.

If interested in pit pullers, please check availability, and pay at the Stat office during individual registration.

Camping is permitted on the west side of the range at the 500 and 600 yd lines. Camping is also permitted behind the impact area on the west side of the range. **NO ONE is permitted to be at camp sites during the match.**
