- Service rifle champion MUST be PA resident with PRPA membership

June 8th Four man team match, \$10.00 per firing team member.

Range Time: Gate to open 7:00 daily. June 6th start 10:00, June 7 & 8, 9:00 start.

Regional & State championship preregistration is required. (Use the form on Page 3) Entries close: June 4th Post entry fee \$10.00. EIC/Director's match fees to be paid the day of the event. Team match fee can be paid in advance or the day of the event.

General Information: Camping is permitted on west side of the 500 & 600 yard lines. No one is permitted in to be at the 500 yard camping area during the match. There is no water or power on the range, portable sanitation units are stationed at the pit, 300, 600, and 1000 yard lines.

COURSE OF FIRE

Friday June 6th EIC and Director's match.

Civilian Marksmanship Program Rifle Excellence in Competition Match, National Match Course consisting of 50 shots (no sighting shoots) per CMP competition rules – latest edition. Eligible rifles: M1, M14, M16A2, M16A4, or commercial rifle of same type and caliber. See CMP rules for more details. Competitors must supply their own safe ammunition. No awards will be presented at the match. All scores will be submitted to CMP for Excellence-In-Competition awards schedule. In the event there are less than 6 non-distinguished shooters entered, the event will be a director's match only.

200 yards. 10 shots standing slow fire in 10 minutes on SR target.

200 yards. 10 shots rapid from standing to sitting in 60 seconds on SR target.

300 yards. 10 shots rapid from standing to prone in 70 seconds on SR-3 target.

600 yards. 20 shots prone slow fire in 20 minutes on MR-1 target.

Saturday June 7th Regional and Service Rifle Championship. 2 sighters at each stage.

Match #1 200 yards. 20 record shots standing slow fire in 22 minutes on SR target.

Match #2 200 yards. Two 10 shot record strings rapid fire sitting, 60 seconds each on SR target.

Match #3 300 yards. Two 10 shot record strings rapid fire prone, 70 seconds each on SR-3 target.

Match #4 600 yards. 20 record shots slow fire prone in 22 minutes on MR-1 target.

Sunday June 8th Four man team match. 2 sighters at each stage.

200 yards. 23 minutes for two firing team members. 10 record rounds each. SR target

200 yards. One 10 shot record string rapid sitting per team member, 60 seconds, SR- target

300yards. One 10 shot record string rapid prone per team member, 70 seconds SR-3 target

600 yards. 23 minutes for two firing team members. 10 rounds each. MR-1 target

Team Captains have the choice of single or pair firing during slow fire relays.
